SQ-863	Recorded Issue Document – Improved Visibility for Required Fields in Vigilance Reporting	An asterisk has been added next to the "Justification of Decision" and "Is Reportable" fields in recorded issue documents on vigilance reporting. This update makes it easier for users to identify required fields, by improving visibility, the change enhances efficiency and ensures that mandatory fields are filled out correctly, supporting compliance and accurate reporting.
SQ-871	Equipment - Improved Scheduling Value Retention	<p>Scheduling values in the equipment workflow are now retained instead of being reset when sending equipment for review.
